-  Narayana Health (formerly known as Narayana Hrudyalaya)
-  Large private hospital network, based out of Bengaluru
-  Founded by Dr. Devi Shetty (2000)






-  The Radiology department in the institute has branched into subspecialty, with each group having individual team of their own.
-  The fellowship course will be entirely in Narayana Institute of Cardiac Sciences (NICS), part of Narayana Health city (Bengaluru).

# The department








-  The Cardiothoracic Imaging Unit is equipped with two CT scanners (256 slice MDCT and dualsource CT scanners) and 2 MRI scanners (1.5 Tesla and 3 Tesla MR systems).
-  The unit is led by Dr. Vimal Raj and is staffed with other consultants and junior staff.
-  Average case load: 100-120 cardiac cross sectional studies (CT and MR) per day



# Highlights of the fellowship





-  Fellowship in Cardiothoracic Imaging is a 1 year position
-  Fellows are expected to work for 6 days a week, 12 hours a day.
-  There will be no night duties.
-  Fellows are entitled to all public holidays (as per NH schedule) and 25 days of leave during their tenure.
-  Monthly stipend - Rs. 55,000



# Highlights of the fellowship






-  The case spectrum include pediatric and adult congenital cardiac diseases, vascular studies and structural heart imaging.
-  Advanced imaging techniques such as myocardial perfusion MRI, strain imaging and preinterventional imaging is a routine practice



# Highlights of the fellowship



-  The fellows are responsible for all the planning and protocols of individual patients, under guidance.
-  All the reports are initially drafted by the fellows, and will be verified by the consultants.
-  The fellows are not expected to verify any reports on their own.



# Highlights of the fellowship



There are numerous opportunities to initiate and continue ongoing research work in the department



The fellows are encouraged to present papers and posters in national / international conferences



Training of the fellow will be in accordance with the European Society of Cardiovascular Imaging (EACVI) guidelines in Cardiac Magnetic Resonance (CMR) imaging.



The fellow will then be eligible to apply for level III certification from the EACVI for CMR
