Documents & Items to Bring


1. White coat

3. Original Aadhaar Card (for verification)
4. Self-attested photocopy of Aadhaar Card (to be retained by the organizing team as ID proof)
5. Signed letter (with official seal) from the Training Department Fellowship Coordinator confirming:
 - o (a) Overall progression of training as per the approved plan
 - o (b) Attendance completed till 31st March 2026
(This letter will be retained by the organizing team.)

During the Viva Examination

1. No tea, coffee, snacks, mobile phones, or any electronic gadgets are permitted inside the viva room. All phones must be deposited in the cloak room.
2. Each case will be assessed by the examiners.
3. Candidates are expected to briefly introduce the images, describe observations, provide interpretation, suggest diagnosis, and discuss further management.
4. Probing questions will be asked, and academic discussions may take place.
5. During counselling, both strengths and areas of improvement will be discussed. A summary statement will be prepared and shared with the Fellowship Coordinator of the candidate's training centre. The discussion will be led by ICRI SSH.
